Bétonsalon is a centre for art and research located in the 13th arrondissement, on the Université de Paris campus, in the Bibliothèque François Mitterrand district.

The space is located on the ground floor of the Halle aux Farines building. With its high ceiling, the exhibition space covers an area of 160 sq.m.

The raw concrete of the floor and walls gives this space an industrial feel. The space remains bright and open to the outside, thanks to the large windows of the facade overlooking the Pierre Vidal-Naquet Esplanade.

On one level, opening onto a pleasant tree-lined square, the entire first floor is wheelchair-accessible.

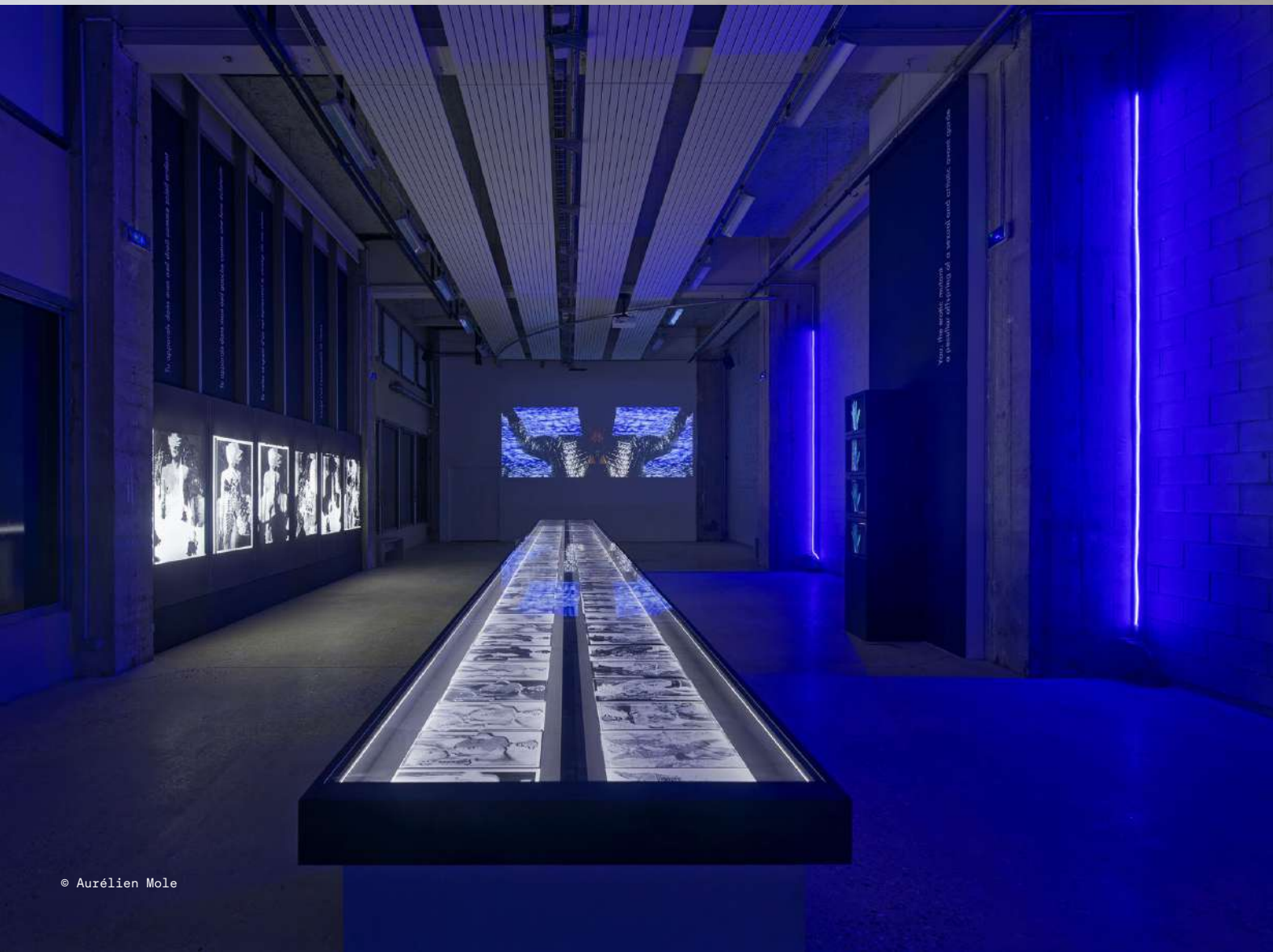

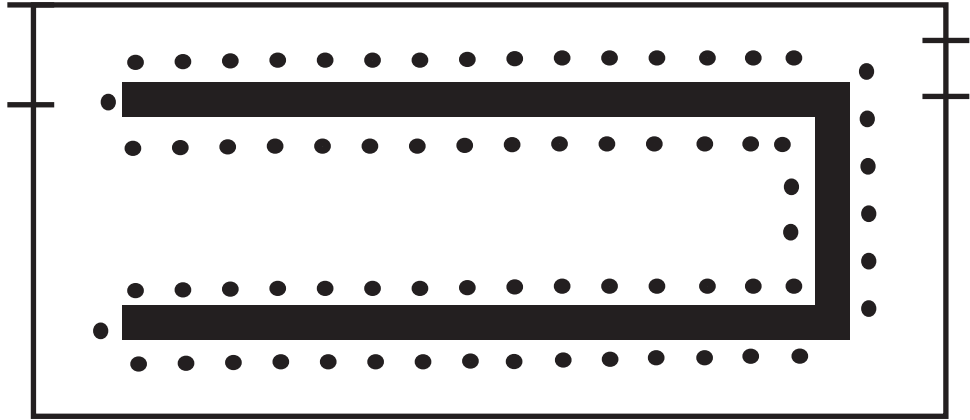
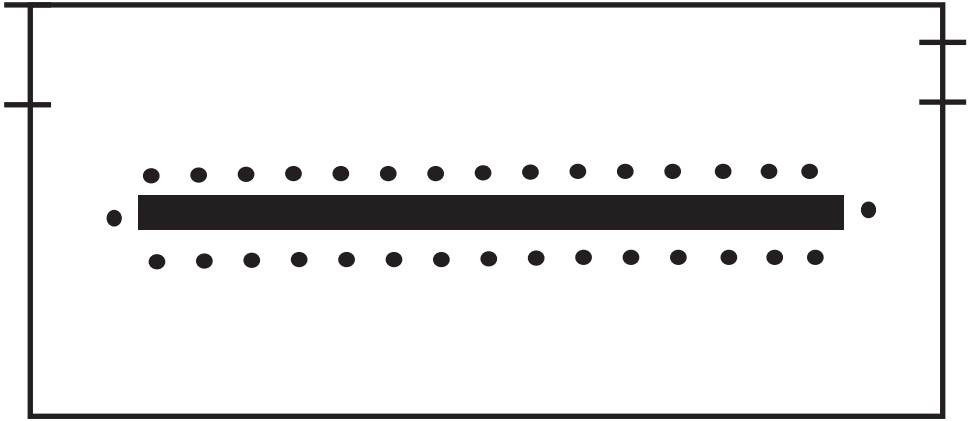
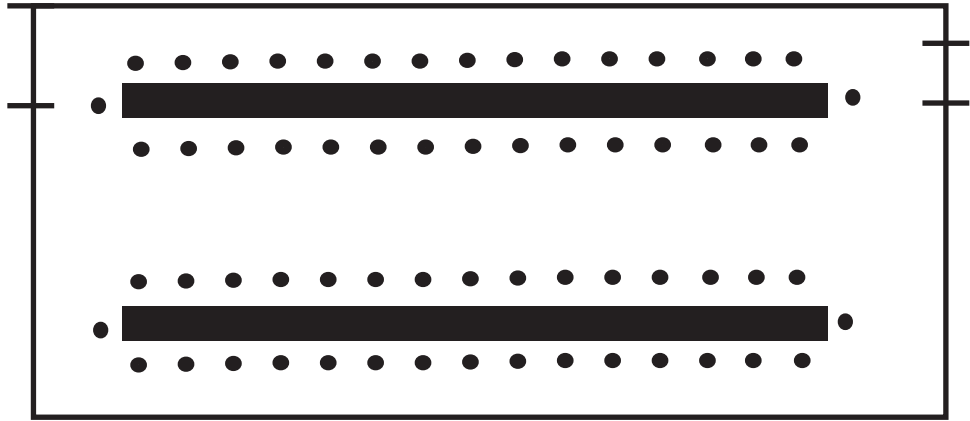
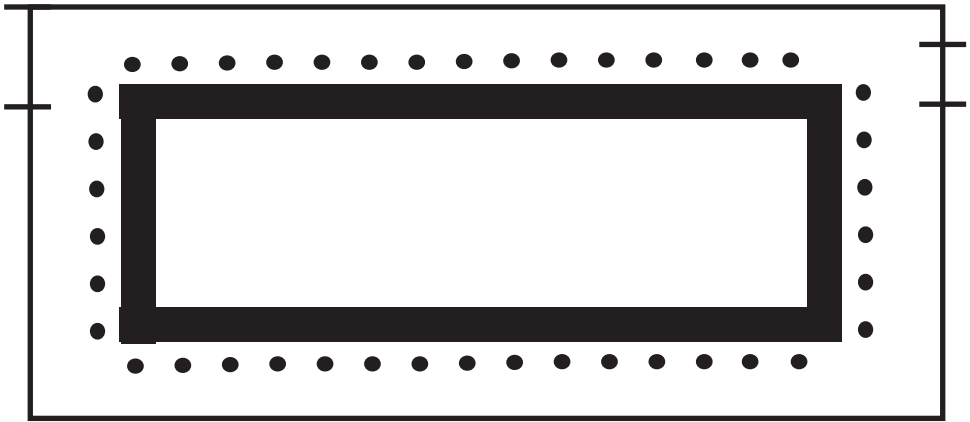
The concrete wall can only be drilled in the joints

POSSIBLE LAYOUTS



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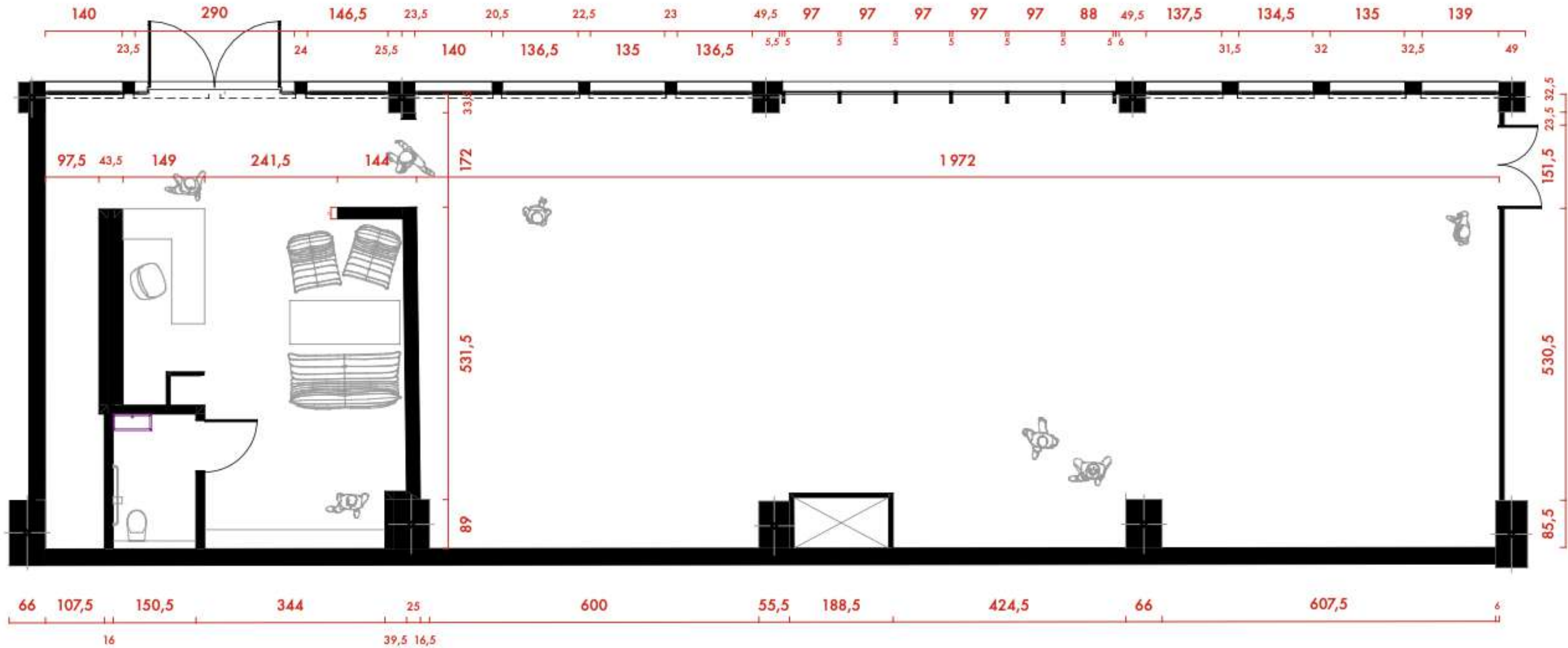


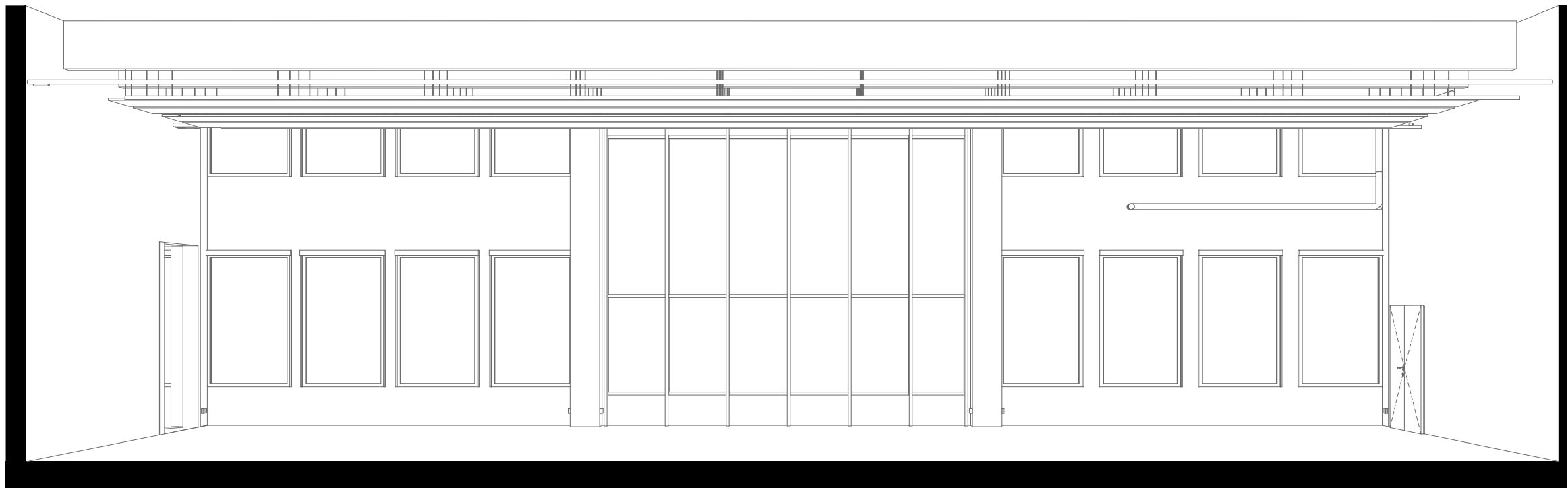
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FLOOR PLAN

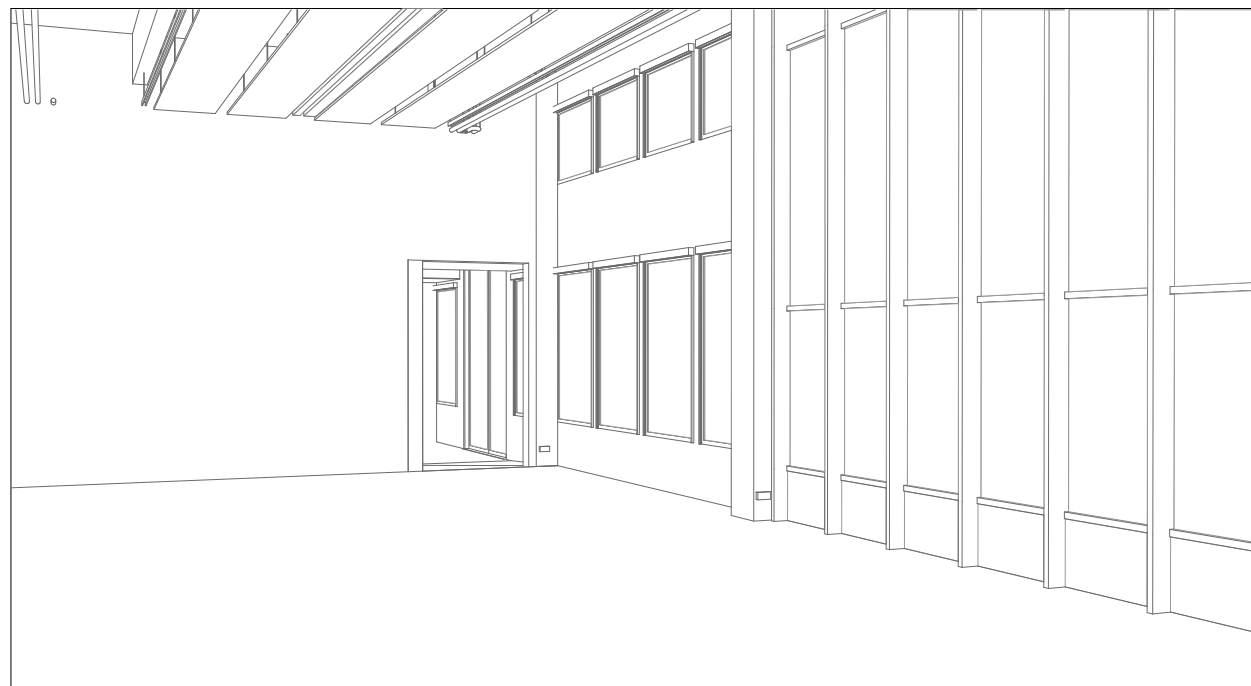

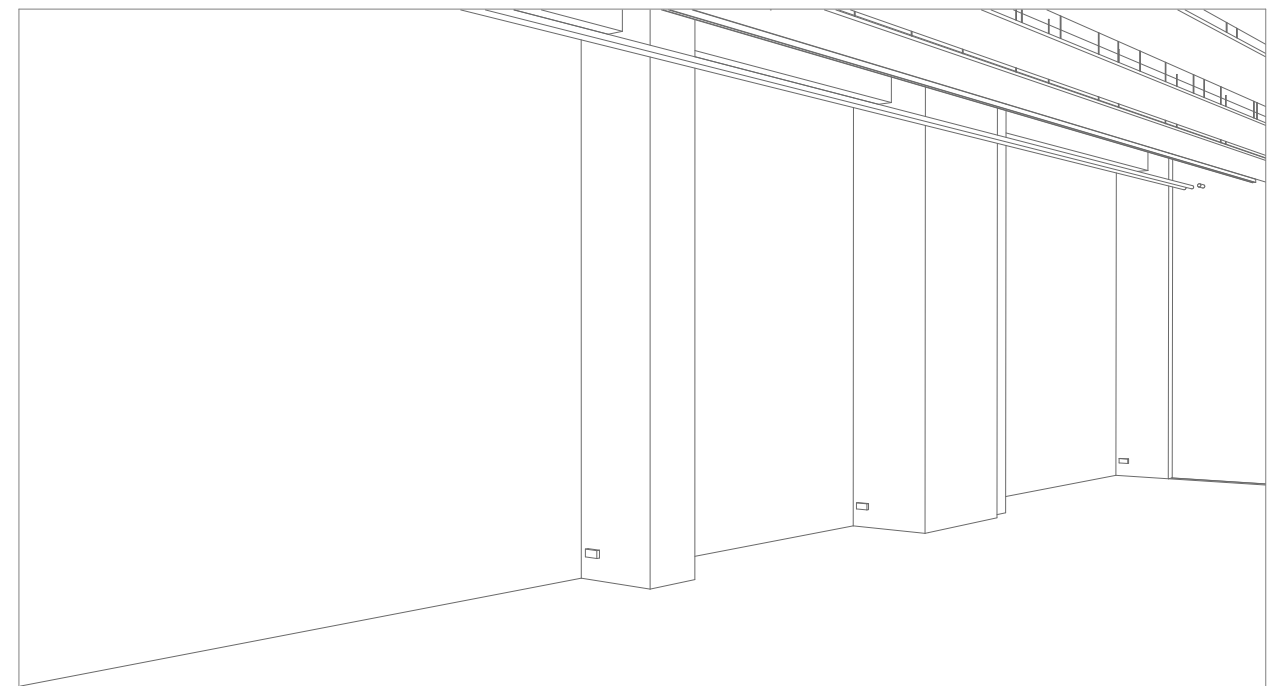
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NORTHWEST PERSPECTIVE



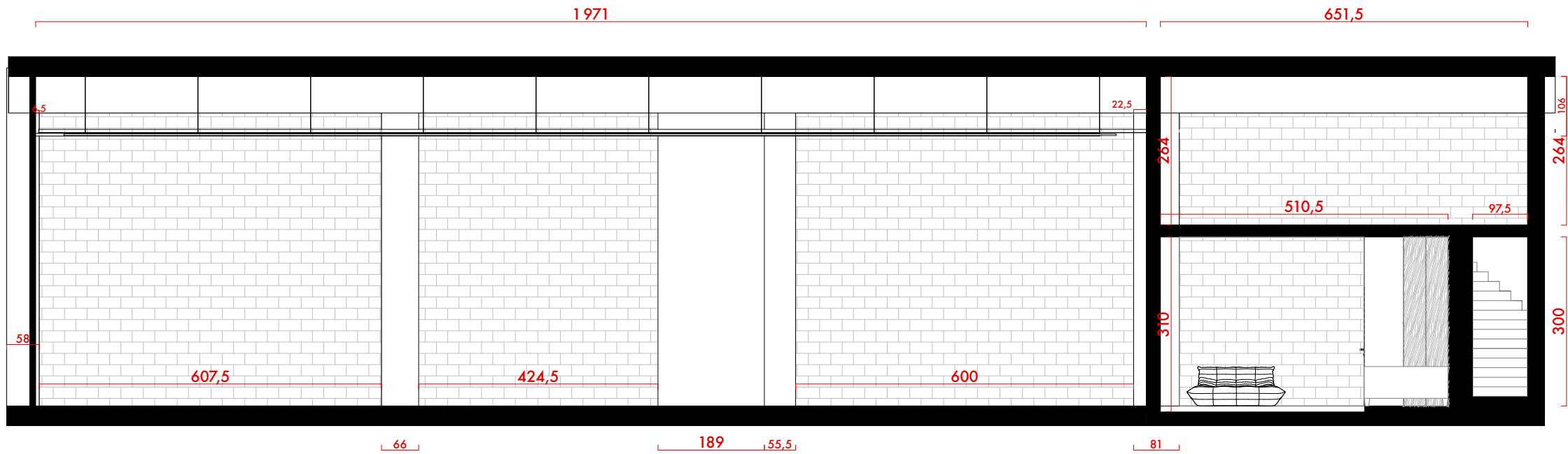
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SOUTHWEST PERSPECTIVE



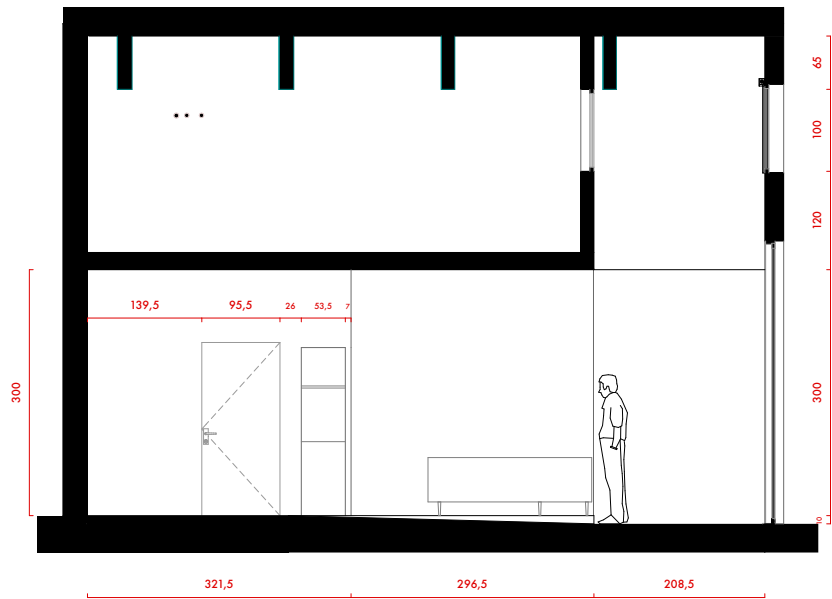
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ELEVATIONS



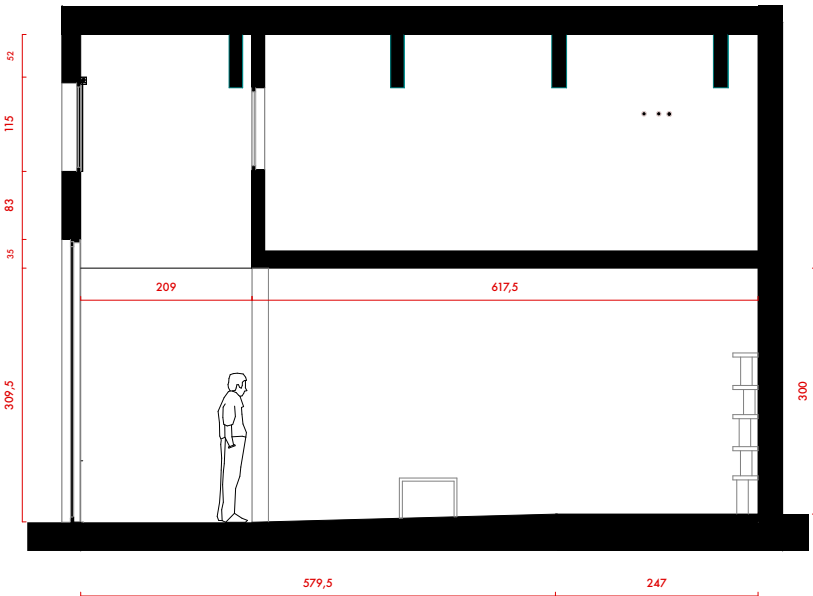
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CROSS-SECTION ENTRANCE
